

## **Steamboat Lake Water & Sanitation District**

Most properties within Filings 1-4 are currently part of the Steamboat Lake Water and Sanitation District (SLWSD). However, the SLWSD does not provide services to many of the properties, and water and sewer is only available to less than 300 lots in the subdivision.

The SLWSD is a separate entity from the WCPVA, and is responsible for the water distribution system, fire hydrants, waste lines, and sewer treatment plant.

For properties not receiving services, there is a process in place to be removed from the District. Contact the SLWSD for details.

Property owners wishing to acquire water or sewer taps should direct their enquiry to the SLWSD Board of Directors. Water & sewer taps are allowed from May 15 to October 15 of each year. No taps will be allowed after October 15. This policy is strictly enforced.

The SLWSD Board sends a newsletter to Class A and Class B members each quarter. Board meetings are held the second Tuesday of the month at 7pm at the Steamboat Lake State Park Visitor Center, and are open to the public.
